**Deadline:** March 29, 2018

**Selection Criteria:** Nominations will be reviewed for the quality and impact of the candidate's service contributions. Successful nominations will demonstrate a sustained and/or enduring contribution to the local community. Nominations can focus on an important body of service contributions over a significant period of time, or one particularly influential contribution.

- Name, address, and email address of the candidate (person being nominated)
- Concise statement (maximum of 25 words) describing professional accomplishment for which the candidate merits this award.
