

North Carolina Society of Acupuncture and Asian Medicine Distinguished Service Award

The NCSAAM Distinguished Service Award recognizes a member who has provided outstanding service to the profession of acupuncture as a whole through research, publication and/or advocacy on the local and national level, provided visionary leadership, and community service. Individuals, or in special cases a small group, are selected on the basis of the value and degree of their service overall, including activities on behalf of the Association. The Distinguished Service Award is the highest award provided by the NCSAAM and is presented at the NCSAAM Annual Member Meeting.

Deadline: March 29, 2018

Selection Criteria: Nominations will be reviewed for the quality and impact of the candidate's service contributions. Successful nominations will demonstrate a sustained and/or enduring contribution to the acupuncture community. Nominations can focus on an important body of service contributions over a significant period of time, or one particularly influential contribution.

Submissions: Nominations for this award should be submitted to director@ncsaam.org along with the following information:

- Name, address, and email address of the candidate (person being nominated).
- Concise statement (maximum of 25 words) describing the key technical or professional accomplishment for which the candidate merits this award.
